

Entry Guidelines



Entries are strictly limited to 3 individual entries from each year groups (P3, P4, P5, P6, P7, Year 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, Special Units) up to a maximum of 12 entries per school.

Group entries are not eligible.

Performances may be on any instrument (including voice) and may last a maximum of 2 minutes for primary level entries and 4 minutes for secondary level entries.

Entries will be judged at an adjudication day at ISLAND Arts Centre in May 2024 (date TBC). Entrants will be required to bring an accompanist (if required) to the adjudication day. A piano and music stand will be provided if required.

Visual Art, Poetry and Short Story Categories

Entries are strictly limited to 3 individual entries from each class (P3, P4, P5, P6, P7, Year 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and Special Units).

All entries must be clearly labelled using the label template supplied on this entry form. Entries which are not correctly labelled may be disqualified. Please attach entry label to the back of the entry.

All submissions must be the **original work** of the young person.

All entries in these categories must be mounted onto card/paper not exceeding A2 size inclusive of mount.

Pupils are encouraged to submit visual art entries in any possible medium but are restricted to wall- mountable pieces only.

Drama Category

Entries to the Drama category must be made on the official entry form indicating the date, times, and place of the performance.

The judging panel will then send adjudicators for judging if available.

At least 14 days' notice must be given for any performance entered.

All entries must be viewed by ISLAND Arts Centre official judges.

Each school may enter a maximum of 2 performances which may include plays, musicals and/or pantomimes. There are separate categories for Primary (KS1&2), Secondary and Special (KS1&2).



Judging

All competition entries will be judged by pre-selected local art form volunteers. For Visual Art, Poetry and Short Story categories, prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place winners in each year group. For Musical Performance and Drama categories, prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place winners in each category (primary, secondary, special schools).

All winning entries will be invited to attend the Gala Awards ceremony and will be awarded certificates and prizes. Overall winning schools in each category will receive a trophy.

Terms & Conditions

The decision of the judging panel is final. No correspondence will be entered into regarding that decision.

ISLAND Arts Centre reserves the right to use images of the winning submissions and winners in future arts publicity campaigns.

ISLAND Arts Centre does not accept responsibility for lost or damaged artwork. Schools are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of competition entries.

All entries must be collected by the end of September 2025.

The judging panel reserves the right to refuse or to cancel any entries, disqualify competitors and prohibit exhibition of works as the judging panel may deem expedient.

The Annual Schools' Arts Competition is open to schools within the Lisburn & Castlereagh City Council Area.
