Contemporary Art of Northern Ireland #4 9 - 30 Sept | Gallery 545

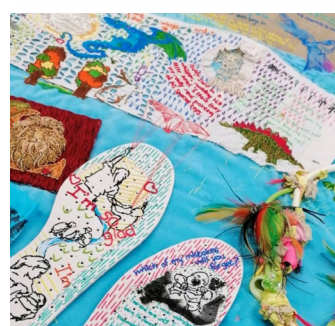
